Notice is hereby given that Miami-Dade County Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) will conduct a **Community Meeting** regarding the subject project on **Tuesday, September 9, 2014, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., at the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Training Facility Headquarters Auditorium, located at 9300 NW 41st Street, Doral, FL 33178.**

This Community Meeting will be conducted to provide area residents and businesses with information related to the construction phase of the project. The project consists of widening and reconstructing the existing road from a five-lane undivided to a six-lane divided roadway with turn lanes, bike lanes, raised median, sidewalks, curb and gutter, continuous storm drainage system, pavement markings and signing, traffic signalization, roadway lighting, landscaping and irrigation.

Funding for this project will be provided by the Charter County Transit Surtax levied pursuant to Section 29.121 of the Code of Miami-Dade County. This project was specifically listed in the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) as one of the Board requested major roadway improvement projects. Additionally, project costs will be reimbursed by FDOT through a Local Agency Program (LAP) agreement. After the completion of the expansion of NW 74 Street from the Homestead Extension of the Florida Turnpike (HEFT) to the Palmetto Expressway (SR 826), the roadway will be transferred to FDOT and will become State Road/SR-934.

The construction plans, maps, drawings and other pertinent information developed by PWWM will be available for public review at the meeting site from 6:30 pm until 8:00 pm the day of the meeting. The first part of the Community Meeting provides an opportunity for attendees to view the construction plans and to discuss the project with PWWM staff. During the second part, which is expected to begin at 7:00 pm, there will be a brief presentation of the project, followed by a question and answer period for the remainder of the meeting.

It is the policy of Miami-Dade County to comply with all of the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990. The meeting facility is ADA accessible.
