--NOTICE OF REQUIRED INSPECTIONS--
(PRESSURE VESSELS/BOILERS/HOT WATER HEATERS, ETC.)

TO ALL TOWN OF MEDLEY BUSINESSES

The Miami-Dade County Code Compliance Department has informed the Town of Medley Building and Zoning Department that all pressure vessels within the limits of the Town of Medley must be inspected. This requirement is set forth in Section 8-11 of the Miami-Dade Municipal Code.

Pressure vessels include tanks that hold water or materials that are under pressure. These vessels include hot water boilers, steam boilers, air storage tanks and liquid storage sealed containers. A more complete list of vessels is found at the bottom of the attached Application for Inspection Form. You are required to deliver the attached Application for inspection of pressure vessel for each such vessel that is located at your business premises. The **charge** for this inspection is **\$75.00** per vessel and must be paid with the completed form for each vessel.

The inspection will consist of a visual check of the pressure vessel, the area of location and mechanical devices attached. If any pressure vessel or any mechanical devices attached to a vessel are found to be defective a licensed plumbing or mechanical contractor must make the appropriate repairs, after obtaining the proper permits from the Town of Medley.

NOTE: High-pressure boilers must be inspected every six months. Low pressure boilers must be inspected every twelve (12) months.

Failure to comply with this request may result in your local business tax receipt being revoked.
