LAKESIDE COMMUNITY CENTER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Following the Town's primary mission to safeguard the public, promote the health, safety and welfare of residents and businesses, the Town of Medley is communicating that it is submitting an application for a CDBG-MIT grant to fund the improvements to the Lakeside Park, including the hardening of the Community Center new drainage system, shoreline repairs, roadway reconstruction, and new culvert bridge connection to NW 116th Way for access during emergencies.

This project is an effort led by the Capital Improvements Projects and Economic Development team to mitigate any damage and future loss of property from recurring flooding events and it is considered a strategic investment to address the deficiencies of the existing infrastructure. It will minimize risks and reduce losses on a service area with over 60% of low to mid income residents.

As shown in previous storm events, this area has been severely disrupted with severe flooding, shoreline erosion and roadway failures. In the past, the Town has completed about 600 linear feet of bank stabilization and is currently in the process of the design and permitting for an area to complete this project.

Investing in mitigation projects of this nature will improve the Town's resiliency by protecting our residents, and will enhance the CDBG-MIT community lifelines of safety and security, transportation and health and medicine.
