The Local Planning Agency (LPA) Board will consider and make recommendations on the following Ordinances:

1. Ordinance of the Town of Medley, Florida, Amending Chapter 62 “Zoning” by Amending Section 62-88(a) “M-1 Industrial District” to Remove Testing of Airplane Engines as a Permitted Use; Amending Section 62-88(b) to Allow Such Use by Special Exception; Providing Criteria for the Approval of Such Special Exception; Providing for Conflicts; Providing for Severability; and Providing for an Effective Date.
